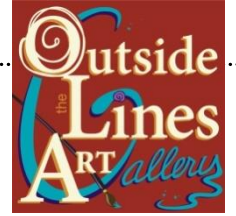

The Great Draw Senior Scholarship Application

ABOUT THE SCHOLARSHIP

In the fall of 2016 Outside the Lines Art Gallery hosted its 5th Annual Street Art Competition called *The Great Draw*. Over 70 area artists of all ages competed for cash and prizes and \$500 dollars was raised to fund this scholarship for a 2017 Senior High School graduate. The goal of the scholarship is to support a student who is beginning their journey as a professional artist.

Applicants must be attending a two or four year college and plan to **major or minor** in the **visual or graphic arts**. Applicants must already be accepted into the school of their choice and be able to provide a copy of their letter of acceptance upon request.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

PORTFOLIO

Digital submissions preferred. Include six to ten images in jpeg format, PC compatible. Images should be 200 dpi and no bigger than two MB. Please name files with your last name and title (Smith_Old_Tree.jpeg) and also include a separate document listing the title, media, dimensions, and year completed, for each image. The order of the document should match the order that the images are viewed. Make sure to put your name on all materials submitted.

Hard copies of all information may also be submitted and dropped off to Outside the Lines Art Gallery, 409 Bluff Street, Dubuque. Images may be submitted on a CD, pen drive or in printed format.

Digital portfolio artwork may include drawings, painting, photography, ceramics, digital works, mixed media, printmaking, sculptures, etc. Digital portfolios may include works created inside or outside of school art classes, preferably within the **past two years**.

ARTIST STATEMENT

Your artist's statement should include a description of the art classes you have taken and the media you have explored, both in and out of high school. It should explain your reasons for wanting to become a professional artist, your goals for yourself, and how you intend to accomplish your goals. In addition, please also list two visual artists whom you admire and state why and how their careers relate to or inspire your own artistic visions and goals.

Your statement should be **at least two full pages** in length (double spaced) no larger than 11 point font. Be sure to include your name at the top of your statement.

LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

A letter of recommendation from a current or past instructor familiar with your artistic qualifications should be included with the application.

Email **applicant information, digital portfolio, and artist statement** by the end of the day on **Friday, April 28, 2017**, to **otlag@aol.com**. All files should be sent in a zip folder titled with your first and last name. The subject line of your email should read: Senior Scholarship Application.

Letters of recommendation should be emailed by your instructor to **otlag@aol.com** and subject line should read: Your Name, Letter of Recommendation.

HARD COPY PORTFOLIO

Hard copies of all application material can be dropped off to Outside the Lines Art Gallery, 409 Bluff Street, Dubuque, no later than **5:00 pm on Friday, April 28, 2017**. If you want your portfolio returned to you, included a SASE.
